TransForce Reports Very Safe Driving Results

SPRINGFIELD, Va. - TransForce Inc., the nation's leading provider of outsourced drivers to the trucking industry, announces its ***three-year DOT recordable accident rate of only 0.29 accidents per million miles***. This rate takes into account all Department of Transportation (DOT) reportable accidents and all miles driven by TransForce drivers in the years 2008, 2009 and 2010. DOT reportable accidents are those that involve any of the following: 1) a fatality, 2) an injury that requires immediate treatment away from the scene of the accident, or 3) disabling damage to a vehicle, requiring it to be towed.

The statistic is remarkably low by comparison to industry benchmarks. The National Private Truck Council reports an average for private carriers of 0.435 crashes per million miles traveled, based on their 2010 annual benchmarking survey. This benchmark accident rate for private fleets is one and a half times higher than TransForce's accident rate.

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) does not report an industry average crash rate for all motor carriers, but FMCSA does track average recordable truck crash rates for carriers that undergo compliance reviews (audits). The chart below shows an average crash rate for audited carriers for 2008, 2009 and 2010 of 0.725 crashes per million miles, two and a half times higher than TransForce's rate.

TransForce fosters a culture of safety with drivers from the initial contact through each and every project. All TransForce drivers are subject to a screening process that ensures they exceed the Department of Transportation (DOT) standards. TransForce publishes an in-house safety newsletter - ***In the Safety Zone*** - that serves to promote safe driving practices among truck drivers.
